- The Dallas Junior Symphony, Michael Coren, conductor
- The Dallas String Ensemble, Franklin Washburn, conductor
- 1986 **The Young Performers Orchestra** is founded, Marilyn D'Autenuil conductor
- 1990 GDYO initiates the **Meyerson Concert Series** with a season of 4 full-length concerts in the Morton H. Meyerson Symphony Center
- 1994 **First European Tour – France/Switzerland - 6 concerts in**
- 1996 **Second European Tour – France-9 concerts**
- 1997 **DSO Music Director Andrew Litton** makes first annual guest conducting appearance
- 1997 **The Sinfonietta** is founded, Louise Rossi, conductor
- 1998 **Third European Tour - Great Britain-8 concerts**
- 1999 **The Wind Symphony** is founded with David Kehler, conductor
- 2000 GDYO selected for American Symphony Orchestra League's **National Youth Orchestra Festival**
